A SPIRIT-DRIVEN LIFE IS A LIFE DOMINATED, EMPOWERED AND INSPIRED BY THE PERSON OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.

1. REMEMBER THAT WHO OR WHAT DOMINATES YOUR LIFE THE MOST WILL LEAD YOU.

KNOWING the HOLY SPIRIT is our FOUNDATION!

(ACKNOWLEDGE HIS PERSON)

TO KNOW THE HOLY SPIRIT IS TO KNOW WHO HE IS NOT:

- He is not a white bird, a cloud, a wind, a euphoria that surrounds the throne of God.
- He is not even a **"Charismatic Bartender"** that pours us emotional drinks that make us feel good all of the time.
- The HOLY SPIRIT is not God's "Errand Boy" for "Signs and Wonders."
- The HOLY SPIRIT is more than an EXPERIENCE!
-EXPERIENCES are momentary... RELATIONSHIP is PERMANENT!
-Experiences are the result of His sovereignty and relationship is the result of your pursuit.

WHO THE HOLY SPIRIT IS MATTERS THAN WHAT HE DOES!

-A SPIRIT-DRIVEN LIFE

EMBRACE HIS PERSON AS PRECIOUS

-What makes Him so wonderful as a person is- a person can feel your pain, understand your purpose, and instruct your potentials.

2. BREAK THROUGH YOUR DAILY BATTLES IN LIFE IN THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT!

Luke 4:1-14 NIV

1Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the desert, 2where for forty days he was tempted by the devil. He ate nothing during those days, and at the end of them he was hungry... 13When the devil had finished all this tempting, he left him until an opportune time. 14Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about him spread through the whole countryside.

3. COVET THE ANOINTING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT AS YOU FULFILL YOUR CALLING!

Luke 4:17-19 NIV

17The scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. Unrolling it, he found the place where it is written: 18"***The Spirit of the Lord is on me***, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed, 19to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

CONCLUSION:

Surrender all. He will only influence the areas of your life that you have made accessible.
